## Physical signing and witnessing

## How can this form be signed?

This form needs to be printed, and the person making the claim\* must sign the printed form in the presence of an *eligible witness*.

## Who can be an eligible witness?

A person who is an eligible witness must observe the person making the claim\* sign the printed form. A person is an eligible witness if they are:

- a justice of the peace (JP);
- a commissioner for declarations (Cdec);
- · a notary public;
- a lawyer;
- a licensed conveyancer in another State or Territory;
- any person who is authorised by law to administer an oath in another State or Territory; or
- another person prescribed by regulation under the Oaths Act 1867 (Qld).

<sup>\*</sup> The person making the claim includes the injured person or a person who is making the claim on behalf of an injured person who is under a legal incapacity.
