Re MAIC review of Third Party Insurance.

I would suggest that, as this insurance is a compulsory part of motor vehicle registration in Queensland, it should be managed by a single entity.

As it is in some other states, The QLD State Government should take full responsibility for the scheme.

There is no appreciable difference in the policies offered by the three current providers... and their fee is exactly the same.

Therefore to reduce the current duplication of services and unnecessary staff the state should take on full responsibility for the scheme.

This improved efficiency should lead to a lowering of the annual premium.
